May 10, 2011, during yesterday's meeting was the first meeting where the system was successfully used and integrated with Legistar, our legislative workflow and document management application for agenda management.

That synchronization between the agenda and the video is triggered by Billy Urquia through Legistar and Granicus Live Manager before and during the meeting.
